

**A** – age

**T** – time of incident / onset

**M** - Mechanism of injury / Medical complaint

**I** – Injuries / information related to complaint

**S** – Signs (vitals)

**T** – Treatments

**A** – Allergies

**M** – Medication

**B** - Backgrounds history

**O** – other information

**Ambulance paramedics are asked to:**

- Review handover details pre-arrival
- Maintain a 20-30 second period where the patient remains on the stretcher and deliver the ATMIST information uninterrupted
- Encourage questions on completion of ATMIST
- Treating paramedic to remain with patient during handover

**ED Clinicians are asked to:**

- Ensure the handover remains interruption free
- Ask questions during provided opportunities after ATMIST AMBO
- Observe “hands-off, Eyes on” a 20-30 second period provided when the patient stays on the ambulance trolley until the ATMIST information is delivered
- Identify team roles
